Larry R. Cauldwell, of Branson West, formerly of Willow Springs, passed away early Thursday morning while at Forsyth Nursing and Rehab Center due to natural causes. Born to Herschel "Bud" and Sophia (Blank) Cauldwell on April 22, 1946 in Willow Springs, MO; he was 71 years old.

Larry grew up in the Willow Springs area. He attended the first eight grades of school at Stony Point, a one-room schoolhouse north of Willow Springs. He also attended Willow Springs High School. Larry proudly served his country in the U. S. Army in the Philippines as a marksman. He was employed by Howard Construction for several years and later worked for Midwest Walnut for more than 30 years until his retirement. On June 13, 2013, he was married to Paula Kay Grubbs and the two moved to Branson West. He also enjoyed spending time on his pontoon boat, and flying his drone until he crashed it. However, he immediately purchased another one to replace it. He will be greatly missed by his family, friends, and all who knew him.

Larry is preceded in death by his parents; his late wife, Barbara; a son, Wesley Cauldwell; a sister, Rene Cauldwell; and a brother, Bill Cauldwell.
