Perry "Perk" L. Younger, a resident of Mountain View, MO passed away Sunday morning, June 10, 2018 while at his home, due to natural causes. Born June 27, 1938 to William Henry and Ossie Lucinda (Sanders) Younger in Eminence, MO; he was 79 years old.

Perk grew up in the Eminence area and attended elementary school at Alley Springs. He started working at the age of 13 as a logger. When he was 16 he started in the construction business.
