



## Mrs. Barbara Adell (Daniels) Friga

Barbara Adell (Daniels) Friga passed away peacefully at her home in Pomona surrounded by her children on Monday afternoon, January 10, at the age of 90. She was born on September 4, 1931, in Mountain View, Missouri, to Fate and Lillian (Saddoris) Daniels, the second of five children. She married the love of her life, Michael “Tony” Friga, on November 10, 1951, in Willow Springs.
