Beth (Ferguson) Vaughn, a resident of Fordland, MO, formerly of Willow Springs, passed away peacefully Wednesday morning, May 29, 2019 in her home. Born June 3, 1921 to Oscar and Bessie (Howell) Ferguson in Willow Springs, she was 97 years old.

Beth grew up in the Willow Springs area and received her elementary education at West Liberty School. She attended and graduated from Willow Springs High School. She was also a great cook and her favorite foods were fried potatoes with onions, brown beans, and cornbread. She will be greatly missed by her family, her friends, and all who knew her.

She is preceded in death by her parents; her husband; her brothers: Jack, Dean, Arthur, Ward, Cecil, and John; and two sisters, Doris and Dixie.
