Chances are that if you knew Charles "Dave" Hollis, then you have some kind of story to tell from the impression he left behind. His journey began on July 23, 1948 in Chalybeate, MS. He departed this life at the age of 68 on January 21, 2017 in West Plains, MO.

Dave grew up around Walnut, MS. In his younger days he enjoyed playing sports and was considered better than average in his athletic ability.
