



Rev. Charles William Millner

November 29, 1921 - April 6, 2016

The Reverend Charles W. Millner, 94, passed away on April 6, 2016 at his home in Willow Springs. He was born November 29, 1921 in Bogard, MO to James W. and Frieda (Perreten) Millner. He graduated from the University of Missouri School of Agriculture. Upon graduation he served in the U.S. Army during World War II. After his discharge from the Army, he was employed as a county extension agent until due to his father's health, he returned to the family farm.

He was united in marriage to Naomi Bishop and to this union two daughters were born. He was called to the ministry and graduated from Saint Paul's School of Theology with a master's degree of theology. He has served churches in Huntsville, Jefferson City, Willow Springs, Montgomery City, and Mountain View.

His activities included the board of Willow Health Care, Willow Springs Senior Center Board, Willow Springs Library Board, Rotary Club, Munch Board, delivering meals for the Senior Center, and calling bingo at Willow Care. In all of his activities, it was another way of serving God.

He is survived by his wife of 65 years Naomi of the family home; two daughters: Ruth Anne DeKrey (Charles) of Willow Springs and Jan Williamson (Rick) of Mt. Pleasant, IA; four grandchildren: Suzanne Pearson (Travis) of Willow Springs, Kristen Faubus (Daniel) of Fort Worth, TX, Danielle Mathieu, Rogersville, MO, and Aaron Williamson (Emily) of Washington, IA; and five great-granddaughters: Allison and Macy Pearson of Willow Springs, Julia and

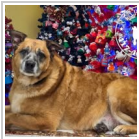

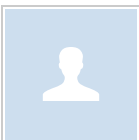
