David Wayne Hocking, a resident of Pomona, MO unexpectedly passed away Tuesday evening, June 4, 2019 in Willow Springs, MO. Born September 18, 1941 to Lucille Barlow Hahn in Quincy, IL; he was 77 years old.

David received his elementary education at Noblett School, and later received his GED certificate. He served the City of Willow Springs for 25 years as a police officer until he retired from law enforcement in 2001. On June 23, 1984 he married Patty Lou Briscoe in Willow Springs, MO. David loved hunting and fishing, watching the birds, being in the country, and caring for his yard. However, he especially loved taking care of his dogs, which included a Yorkie, and coon hounds. He will be dearly missed by his family, his friends, and all who knew him.

He is preceded in death by his grandmother, his mother, and a brother, Ronnie Cunningham.
