Deane W. Recore was born January 21, 1941, in the village of Chateaugay, NY. On November 2, 2016, he passed away of natural causes at Phelps County Regional Health Center, Rolla, MO. He was welcomed Home by his Savior, complete, strong and vigorous. He was 75 years old.

Deane joined the US Air Force in January 1959 and served honorably for 22 years. He received numerous awards and decorations and achieved the rank of Master Sergeant E-7.

He was preceded in death by his parents and an infant son. He is survived by his wife, Dana, of Willow Springs, MO; his 3 children and 4 grandchildren in San Antonio, TX: Debra Bebell and husband Don, Darlene Champion and husband Steve, Darren Recore and wife Tee, and his grandchildren Andrea and Austen Champion and Jake and Calli Recore. He is further survived by his sister Diane Jackson of Orange Park, FL and brother Tom Recore along with numerous nieces, nephews, cousins and friends.

While in the Air Force, Deane spent many years stationed at Lackland AFB in San Antonio TX as a Military Training Instructor. His final tour was at Mather AFB in CA, where he was a Personnel Superintendent. After his retirement, he drove trucks and managed a fast food restaurant. After moving to Willow

Springs, MO in 1984, he owned and operated Gumpy's Restaurant then game room. He then worked for Ozark Action in West Plains, MO.

Deane was an active member of the WS Lions Club, serving as Secretary for many years as well as President. After an illness in 2000, Deane became a resident of the Missouri Veterans Home in St. James. He was known by many residents, staff and visitors. He will be greatly missed for his witty sayings and cheerful attitude.

A memorial service with military honors and inurnment will be held Monday, November 14, 2016 at the National Cemetery, Fort Sam Houston, Texas.
