Deborah L. Joerger, of Mountain View, unexpectedly passed away Sunday, June 11, 2017 while at Cox Medical Center South in Springfield, MO. Born on October 18, 1957 to Roland and Sonia (Richards) Rush, she was 59 years old.

Having grown up in Brunswick, Maine, Debbie attended the local schools and graduated from Brunswick High School.
