Eunice (White) Adams, a resident of Willow Springs, passed away early Wednesday morning while at Willow Care Nursing Home. Born December 27, 1931 in Twin Bridges to Allman and Bertha (Bunch) White, she was 86 years old.

Eunice grew up in the Twin Bridges area and attended elementary school at Round Top Grade School. 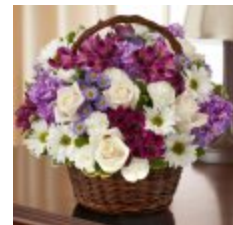
