Herman Earl Hicks, a long time resident of Willow Springs, quietly passed away Tuesday evening while at Kabul Nursing Home in Cabool from natural causes. Born April 17, 1929 in Richville, MO to Sidney and Ruth (Smith) Hicks, he was 86 years old.

Herman was self employed most of his life as a logger and timber worker. It was said he had logged over much of the country here in the Ozarks, and because of that, he was well known throughout the communities and had made numerous friends along the way. He was described by his family as a good Christian man who actually lived by the Christian principles in which he was taught. He was a wonderful husband, father, and grandpa. After the passing of his first wife, Wilma, he later married Lorene Johnson on December 20, 1971 in Vanzant, MO. He had many enjoyments in life which included fishing and hunting. He was also considered quite the jokester, and it wasn't beyond him to pull a prank or two when you weren't looking; however, he especially loved all his family and being able to spend time with them.
