



Robert L. Rodman

March 27, 1920 - June 8, 2015

Long-time Willow Springs resident Mr. Robert Rodman, Jr., passed away on Monday, June 8, 2015 while at Willow Care Nursing Home. Born on March 27, 1920 in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma to Robert L. and Oma B. (McCoy) Rodman, he was 95 years old.

Mr. Rodman grew up in Oklahoma and in his early adult years he worked in the oil fields. Bob proudly served his country in The US Army Air Force during World War II where he was a Staff Sergeant. During his service in the Army, he worked as an Airplane Mechanic Gunner serving in Normandy and Northern France before returning to the US. Bob received numerous ribbons and medals for his service. On October 10, 1946, he married Georgia O. Evans in Norman, Oklahoma and to this union two children were born. In 1953, the couple relocated to Willow Springs where he owned a Case Tractor Dealership and Rodman's Shop (a small engine and saw repair business.) Bob owned a number of businesses before his retirement. He will be greatly missed by his family and friends.

He was preceded in death by his parents; his wife Georgia O. Rodman; and three brothers, Bland, Rollen and Braden Rodman.

Mr. Rodman is survived by his children, Geneice K. Adams of Willow Springs; and his son, Larry Rodman of Willow Springs. He is further survived by his

grandchildren, Chad Stevenson of West Plains; Michael Rodman of Willow Springs; Ashley Rodman of Arkansas; and a great granddaughter, Leah Rodman.
